Identifying Characteristics: Brown birthmark on outside of right elbow, slightly deformed tip of left thumb and nail.

Clothing/Jewelry: Pink tie-dye shirt with a white collar. She wears clear contacts or occasionally glasses.

Circumstances: Unknown. She dropped off an application at a Wendy's near 10th Street in Indianapolis at 7:00 p.m. She bought school supplies and visited Indiana University to drop a class she was taking. At 11:00 p.m., she made a call to a friend from a pay phone at Thornton's gas station on Crawfordsville Road. The line disconnected when the friend picked up the phone, and Molly has never been heard from again. In 2008, authorities announced that they were investigating the case as a homicide. In 2010 **John E. Shelton** and his father **Ed Shelton** were found civilly liable for her wrongful death and were ordered to pay \$3.4 million in damages to her family. Molly's case remains unsolved.
