WHERE IS THE MONEY GOING?

- 1) Profiling the missing on our site and creating templates that make it easy for the volunteer artists to do their job and get the word out to their local missing person and their community. Connecting with families of the missing and law enforcement to make sure the details are correct.
- 2) Hundreds of events coordinating all over the world.
- 3) Posting events on our site and promoting each event and missing person via local media whenever possible.

- 4) Press releases faxed, emailed and phone calls to press world wide.
- 5) Coordinating events and families of the missing with local nonprofits all over the world via, email, fax and phone.
- 6) Coordinating details with venues and artists via email, fax and phone.
- 7) Extensive web site work to make sure the site is easy to move around on.
- 8) Phone calls, emails and faxes with families of the missing and their local law enforcement to coordinate and join forces with GINA Artists at their events to help tell the story of local missing.
- 9) GINA tours the country in a bus for 19 with the faces of missing children and adults all over the bus, gathering, press and media attention in at least 19 U.S. cities.
- 10) Artwork for the bus, traveling artists vehicles and for TOUR posters.
- 11) Create relationship with tour sponsors and coordinate each sponsors donation.
- 12) Gas for Bus
- 13) Food
- 14) Lodging
- 15) Printing costs and phone bills
- 16) Office Supplies
- 17) Filming the stories of the missing for our website, webcasts and UTUBE
- 18) Web casting our events whenever possible to take the word of local missing to an International audience.
